Pastor Call Update

Next Steps

Council will arrange a Call Meeting with the Congregation. The purpose of the Call Meeting will be for the Congregational members to vote on extending the Call to (hiring full time) Pastor Franklin.

Since COVID limits people from gathering, the Call Meeting will actually be a Call Communication information package to the congregation and a mail-in/email-in ballot vote. There will be telephone-call and Zoom-meeting information available to the members prior to submitting the vote.

The information package will include:

- Call Committee Recommendation Analysis
- Pastor Franklin's Biography
- Reference to the short video of Pastor Franklin (refer to the Call Committee Recommendation Analysis)
- Annual Report (with 2022 Budget)

It is expected that the information package will be mailed out the week of February 7. Allowing time for receipt of the information, time to review the information (telephone and Zoom meeting information sessions will be held during this time), and time to receive the ballots, it is expected that the votes will be returned by February 28 and decision made.
